RESOLUTION NO. 2023-02-09.2

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLARENDON, TEXAS, CALLING THE MAY 6, 2023 GENERAL ELECTION OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN AND PROPISITION FOR THE REAUTHORIZATION OF THE LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX IN THE CITY OF CLARENDON AT THE RATE OF .25% TO CONTINUE PROVIDING REVENUE FOR MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF MUNICIPAL STREETS.

WHEREAS, as the regular election for the City Council of the City of Clarendon as set fourth by the Texas Election Code is required to be held on May 6, 2023; at which time the voters will elect persons to fill the Office OF Mayor and two (2) Aldermen, and the reauthorization of the local sales and use tax in the City of Clarendon at the rate of .25% to continue providing revenue for maintenance and repair of municipal streets.

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to conduct joint elections pursuant to the provisions of the Texas Election Code, and as established in a joint election agreement for election services with the Donley County Clerk, serving as the Joint Election Officer.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLARENDON, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1: Unless one or more of the entities qualify under provisions of the Texas Election Code to

cancel their election, the City of Clarendon shall hold a joint election, per the aforesaid joint election agreement for election services, on Saturday, May 6, 2023, for the

purpose of electing members of the City Council.

Section 2: An election is hereby called to elect the Office Mayor and two (2) Aldermen, to a term

that expires in May 2025. Mayor and Aldermen will serve until their successors are duly elected and qualified, and the reauthorization of the local sales and use tax in the City of Clarendon at the rate of .25% to continue providing revenue for maintenance and repair of municipal streets. Such election shall be held at the Donley County Annex, 220 W. 4th

Street, Clarendon, Texas on the 6th day of May 2023, from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Section 3: Vicky Tunnell, Donley County Clerk/Joint Election Officer, is hereby appointed as Early

Voting Clerk. Applications for ballot by mail must be mailed to P.O. Drawer U,

Clarendon, Texas 79226. Attention: Vicky Tunnell, Early Voting Clerk, and received no

later than close of business on Tuesday, April 25, 2023.

Section 4: Early voting shall be conducted at the Donley County Annex, 220 W. 4th Street,

Clarendon, Texas.

Early voting by personal appearance will be conducted each weekday between the hours

of 7:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. beginning on April 24, 2023 and ending on May 2, 2023.

Section 5: Notice of said election shall be given by: (1) publishing notice of election, in English and

Spanish, at least once, on or before the 30th day, April 6, 2023, nor later than the 10th day, April 26, 2023, before election day, in a newspaper of general circulation in said City; and 2) not later than the 21st day before election day, April 15, 2023, by posting notice of election, in English and Spanish, on the City's location for posting notices of

the meetings of the Clarendon City Council.

Section 6: The notice shall include the way and manner of holding said election, the polling places,

the personnel and the officers who are to hold the same, and all details connected with the holding of the election shall be provided for and arranged by the City Secretary. Any omission or irregularity in the notice of election or in the publication or posting of the notice of election, or in the signing of the same, shall not in any way affect or invalidate

such election.

Section 7:

The City Secretary is hereby directed to deliver the notice of the election to the County Clerk and the voter registrar not later than the 60^{th} day (March 7, 2023) before election

day.

Section 8:

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution was adopted and said election was called was open to the public and public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given, all as required by Chapter 551 of the

Texas Government Code.

Section 9:

This resolution and election order shall take effect and be in full force and effect from

and after the date of its passage, and it is so resolved.
