A motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem Jeffers and seconded by Alderman Lockhart to amend the water purchase contract with Greenbelt Municipal and Industrial Water Authority that upon the retirement of the existing contract, the City of Clarendon can terminate the contract with one year notice and must be indemnified and held harmless by the other contracting parties, and remove any language from existing contract that states the City of Clarendon would be financially responsible for any ground water that has been or will be pumped within the corporate boundaries of the city limits of the City of Clarendon. Also, to amend the groundwater sales contract with Greenbelt Municipal and Industrial Water Authority for raw water sales to include that the agreement can be cancelled by either party with one year's notice. With each Alderman voting AYE, the motion carried.
